Multiservice passive chilled beams were used to provide the "wow" factor to this highly prestigious new-build headquarter development. The beams were carefully designed to complement the curved floor-plan of the building and provide a light and airy feel for building occupants. The beam casing is provided with a metallic silver finish for an industrial "form and function" look, and the units are linked to the services bulkhead in such a way that they appear to float in free space. Frenger also provided passive and active chilled beams for integration in areas with suspended ceilings, and worked closely with the project engineers to ensure optimal comfort to all locations.
